In July 2024 we held a focus group for Health Innovation East <u>East of England Secure Data</u> <u>Environment</u>.

9 participants attended, offering their feedback and valued opinions on the use of Secure Data Environments and how it should be used for research.

REN DIABETES Information Event



Our REN diabetes research & information event took place on September 10th, 2024 at Sri Guru Ravidass Sabha. This event was extremely well-attended with almost 100 attendees. A large proportion of attendees were from the South Asian diaspora.

Healthwatch Bedford Borough had 18 exhibitors providing information stands.

Oral Health



To support the Bedfordshire <u>Oral Health Improvement Team</u>, HBB have created a bespoke informational website page that provides tips and information on oral health and hygiene for families, particularly those with children aged 0 to 5.

We created two fictional characters to help spread the message of 'Tooth' & 'Paste' and have made 2 educational videos, one with <u>tips</u> and one with <u>oral health information</u>.

As part of this campaign, we have produced 400 wipe-clean tooth cleaning charts with tips for cleaning teeth. These will be promoted during outreach activity, in particular at toddler groups, Children's Centres and other outreach events to ensure that HBB have met our key strategic aim in relation to oral health.
