

A new report published today by NHS Blood and Transplant shows that there is a significant need for more organ donors Black and Asian heritage, in order to help the growing number of patients waiting for life-saving transplants.

Latest figures published today in NHS Blood and Transplant's <u>Annual Recort on Ethnicity Differences in Organ Donation</u> and <u>Transplantation</u> show that in 2021-22, people of Asian horitage represented 3% of doceased donors but 15% of deceased donor transplants and 16% of the transplant waiting list; while those of Black heritage represented 2% of deceased donors but 5% of deceased donor transplants and 10% of the waiting list; similar to figures from the previous ETHNIC MINORITIES ARE ORGAN DONOR REGISTERED
